

The Confession Of Sins

Pastor:

We come into the presence of God today, remembering our sins, and also acknowledging that we all deserve God's punishment. But our gracious Lord has promised each of us, in 1st John 1, "As often as we confess our sins, God is faithful and just, and will forgive our sins, and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Therefore, trusting in God's promise, let us confess our sins:

People:

Lord God, we do not deserve to call You 'Father', because we are not worthy to be called Your children. From the very beginning of our lives, we were conceived and born in sin. We have often lived against You, in our thoughts, words, and deeds. In the name of tolerance, we have not spoken up for all life, even in the womb. In our apathy, we have often failed to defend life, at every stage of existence. We often place politics, and our own sinful agendas, above Your Word. For the sake of Jesus Christ, have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, renew our will to do Your will, and grant us life and salvation in Your Son, Jesus Christ. Amen.

God's Holy Absolution

Pastor:

God's Amazing Grace is more than we can ever deserve. God's love for us is immeasurably more than all we can ask or imagine. In His great love, He sent His only-begotten Son, into the womb of the virgin, to take on our flesh and blood, and to pass through every stage of our existence, without sin; so that He could be our Savior. When Jesus Christ grew up, He satisfied God's wrath against our sins, by His innocent suffering and death on Calvary. By Christ's resurrection from the dead, He has given each of us the assurance that He has conquered and forgiven our sins, and the death that we deserve. Therefore, in the stead, and by the command, of my Lord, Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins, in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

The Old Testament Lesson

Exodus 1:8-2:10

⁸There arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph. ⁹And he said to his people, "Behold, the people of Israel are too many and too mighty for us. ¹⁰Come, let us deal shrewdly with them, lest they multiply, and, if war breaks out, they join our enemies and fight against us and escape from the land." ¹¹Therefore they set taskmasters over them to afflict them with heavy burdens. They built for Pharaoh store cities, Pithom and Raamses. ¹²But the more they were oppressed, the more they multiplied and the more they spread abroad. And the Egyptians were in dread of the people of Israel. ¹³So they ruthlessly made the people of Israel work as slaves ¹⁴and made their lives bitter with hard service, in mortar and brick, and in all kinds of work in the field. In all their work they ruthlessly made them work as slaves.

¹⁵Then the king of Egypt said to the Hebrew midwives, one of whom was named Shiphrah and the other Puah, ¹⁶"When you serve as midwife to the Hebrew women and see them on the birthstool, if it is a son, you shall kill him, but if it is a daughter, she shall live." ¹⁷But the midwives feared God and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but let the male children live. ¹⁸So the king of Egypt called the midwives and said to them, "Why have you done this, and let the male children live?" ¹⁹The midwives said to Pharaoh, "Because the Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women, for they are vigorous and give birth before the midwife comes to them." ²⁰So God dealt well with the midwives. And the people multiplied and grew very strong. ²¹And because the midwives feared God, he gave them families. ²²Then Pharaoh commanded all his people, "Every son that is born to the Hebrews you shall cast into the Nile, but you shall let every daughter live."

¹Now a man from the house of Levi went and took as his wife a Levite woman. ²The woman conceived and bore a son, and when she saw that he was a fine child, she hid him three months. ³When she could hide him no longer, she took for him a basket made of bulrushes and daubed it with bitumen and pitch. She put the child in it and placed it among the reeds by the river bank. ⁴And his sister stood at a distance to know what would be done to him. ⁵Now the daughter of Pharaoh came down to bathe at the river, while her young women walked beside the river. She saw the basket among the reeds and sent her servant woman, and she took it. ⁶When she opened it, she saw the child, and behold, the baby was crying. She took pity on him and said, "This is one of the Hebrews' children." ⁷Then his sister said to Pharaoh's daughter, "Shall I go and call you a nurse from the Hebrew women to nurse the child for you?" ⁸And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Go." So the girl went and called the child's mother. ⁹And Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "Take this child away and nurse him for me, and I will give you your wages." So the woman took the child and nursed him. ¹⁰When the child grew up, she brought him to Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. She named him Moses, "Because," she said, "I drew him out of the water."

The Epistle Lesson

Ephesians 3:14-21

¹⁴For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, ¹⁵from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, ¹⁶that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, ¹⁹and to know the love of Christ that surpasses all knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. ²⁰Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, ²¹to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.





The Lord look upon you with His favor, and give you His peace!


